BASIC CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

FREE TRAINING



The Crime Scene Investigation Course consists of three -2day sessions. These sessions include: Crime Scene Photography, Latent Print Recovery, Basic Evidence Collection. Each session will be presented at various locations across the state. Participants may attend sessions at any location. Upon completion of all three sessions, the participant will be awarded a Basic Crime Scene Investigators Certification.

CRIME SCENE PHOTOGRAPHY

GOAL: The purpose of this course is to provide the participant with the ability to appropriately document crime scenes with digital photography.

Objective: Upon completion of the course, the participant will be able to:

- Document evidence at crime scene or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using the program mode.
- Document evidence at crime scene or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using the portrait mode,
- Document evidence at crime scenes or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using the sports mode.
- Document evidence at crime scenes or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using macro mode.
- Document evidence at crime scenes or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using the aperture priority mode.
- Document evidence at crime scenes or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using the shutter priority mode.
- Document evidence at crime scenes or during criminal investigation activities with a digital camera using the manual mode.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: Each participant will be responsible for providing a digital camera with

automatic and manual modes, tripod, flashlight, appropriate clothing for

current weather conditions.

LATENT PRINT RECOVERY

Goal: The purpose of this course is to provide the participant with the ability to identify and collect latent prints at crime scenes.

OBJEVTIVES: Upon completion of the course, the participant will be able to:

- Identify characteristics of fingerprints
- Roll fingerprint comparison samples
- Develop latent prints using black powder.
- Develop latent prints using magnetic powder.
- Develop latent prints using fluorescent powder.
- Develop latent prints using ninhydrine.
- Develop latent prints using genetian violet.
- Develop latent prints using acitified peroxide.
- Develop latent prints using small particle reageant.
- Develop latent prints using super glue.

CRISIS NEGOTIATION FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

GOAL:

To provide law enforcement officers with techniques to communicate with people who are threatening violence and deescalate the situation and reduce the potential for loss of life or personal injury. The process involves skills such as active listening, empathy, rapport, influence, and control. A variety of mental illness issues are discussed during the training.

OBJECTIVE: Upon completion of the course, the participant will be able to:

- Understand the effects of stress on rational thinking.
- Utilize the Behavioral Stairway to deescalate potentially violent behaviors.
- Utilize strategies to reduce personal stress.
- Understand the roles and assignments in Crisis Negotiation teams.
- Provide support to Crisis Negotiation teams during critical incidents.
