CHANCELLOR'S PROCEDURE FOR POLICY 721.01: CONTINUING EDUCATION

- 1. Continuing education activities may include non-credit courses, seminars, and workshops provided to business and industry, organizations, governmental agencies, and the general public. These may include skills courses, personal enrichment, and professional development activities.
- 2. Colleges shall establish policies and procedures that articulate fee structures, curriculum standards, instructor contract/compensation, and evaluation procedures for continuing education courses regardless of course format.
- 3. Continuing education offered through third party vendors will be monitored by the college.
- 4. Colleges may award appropriate credentials to participants of continuing education activities.
- 5. Continuing Education Units (CEUs) may be awarded in accordance with guidelines established by the International Association for Continuing Education and Training or other appropriately recognized entities.
