DISCUSSION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Course Number: NUR 209 Concepts for Healthcare Transition Students • Course Description: This course introduces the conceptual framework of the nursing program and study of the nursing process. Learning objectives of this course enable the students' transition from the role as a licensed practical nursing to the role of the registered nurse as well as prepare students for the rigors of the concept-based ADN program. • Combined paramedic and LPN course for career mobility; who is eligible? • Course needs to include anything a student needs to know to be successful at the beginning of NUR 211. • Write SLOs to INCLUDE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Fundamental Concepts ○ OB ○ Psych ○ Focus on scope of professional nursing practice • Admission criteria: LPN from new curriculum can return for RN completion within 2 years. MUST meet the 112 entry criteria. • Progression: apply for transfer (from LPN completion) to continue into RN program. Reinstated ONCE. RN completion, not Track 1 and Track 2. • Objectives (to be met by the END of the course) will include only "Manager of care" statements, since 'coordinator' is LPN role/scope and these students have already achieved that level of practice. • NCSBN "Gap Study" provided to attendees by Linda Cater, updated on info from meeting at Alabama Board of Nursing for a Veteran's Bridge program to LPN certificate. • Develop detail of course content after assessing individual cohort needs. Need to revisit this statement to determine where this will best fit and how to assess. • Concepts: reviewed each NEW course POI (112, 113, 114) to determine gaps for PN and Medic to ensure inclusion within this POI. • Credit Hours: 6 Theory, 1 Lab, 3 Clinical = 10 credit hours / 18 contact hours • Clinical Hours: 135 hours = 24 Peds, 24 OB, 24 Psych, 63 Med-surg SUGGESTED 		
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CPL statement: 'credit for prior learning' "Upon successful completion of this course the student will be awarded 15 hours of non-traditional credit." NUR 112, 113, 114 = 25 credit hours LESS the 10 just completed with NUR 209 leaves a balance of 15 credits that need compensation.
