

# An adult who earned 10 or more graduation credits from an Alabama High School and requires additional graduation credits to be awarded an Alabama High School Diploma.

Based on the verified credits (\_\_\_\_\_) from the student's High School transcript, the student may choose the following instructional activities to build credits:

- Student will take portions of the 2014 GED<sup>®</sup> assessment (Math, Social Studies, Science, & and Reasoning through Language Arts) and have a passing score of 145 or higher
  - Scoring 145-164 builds 1 credit per test section
  - Scoring 165 to 174 builds 2 credits per test section
  - Scoring 175 or higher builds 3 credits per test section

#### AND/OR

2) Student will enroll and complete a **Ready –To-Work Program** (if available) builds 3 credits.

\*Note: Timeframe to complete RTW Program may differ at each Adult Education Program.

### AND/OR

- 3) Student will prepare for & take ACT WorkKeys<sup>™</sup> Assessment scoring 4 or higher (silver, gold, or platinum certification) in each area.
  - Scoring level 4 builds ½ Credit per each area
  - Scoring level 5 builds 1 Credit per each area
  - Scoring level 6 builds 2 Credits per each area

\*Note: Preparation time for the ACT WorkKeys<sup>™</sup> assessment will be based on the student's initial TABE assessment, and POI. Professional judgment on part of the Instructor/or AE Director regarding student's preparedness for the assessment will need to be exercised in the event a student wants to take the Workkeys without preparation; however, an initial TABE is required, and student must be enrolled in AAESAP. If student takes the ACT WorkKeys Assessment<sup>™</sup> and is not successful in meeting the requirements, student must complete a program of study (30 or 40 hours based on assessment policy guidelines) before being administered another ACT WorkKeys<sup>™</sup> Assessment.



## AND/OR

4) Student will be enrolled in an approved technical **Career Pathway** (dual enrollment) class at the college level, and will build 1 for 1 credit for each class successfully completed (i.e. 3 credit hours class builds 3 credits).

## AND/OR

5) Student will be referred to the campus **Prior Learning Experience (PLE)** Specialist for decision of potential credit.

\*Note: A Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) may be administered prior to awarding credit.
